THE FEEDBACK MECHANISM

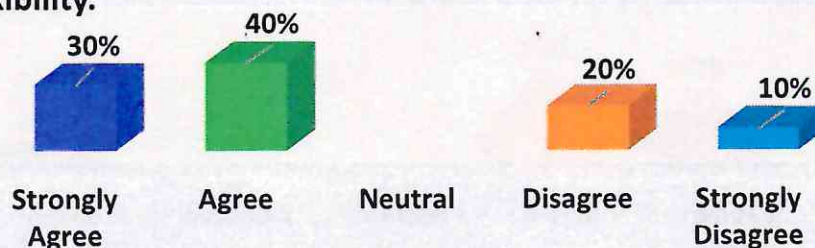
